POOL GETS CONNECTED

Work on a new bus and pedestrian link from Tolvaddon Energy Park to Pool is planned to start in April 2011.

A revised bid has been submitted to the Department for Transport for funding to complete the East-West Link Road. The result of the bid should be known in March.

Work is underway in the Cornwall College grounds from the main College entrance out towards Trevenson Church. This work is to provide a sustainable drainage system for the subsequent developments in and around Heartlands and should be completed by early Spring.

Work on the roads, services and pedestrian links to connect Heartlands Park to Dudnace Lane and the A3047 opposite the College has also been underway for a few months and should be complete by this Autumn in line with the proposed opening of the Park. It will also allow the

first phase of housing on Trevenson Road to come forward together with workspace sites on Dudnace Lane.

This investment is good news for the area, making Pool and the surrounding towns and communities a more prosperous, pleasant and safer place to work, live and play.

MILESTONE AT FORE STREET, POOL

Carn Brea Parish Council try to ensure the preservation of historic sites in the parish. The best way to do this is to apply for listed building status and one of the recent successes is this milestone. It is marked 16P/26L. This is 16 miles to Penzance and 26 miles to Lands End. It is one of a series of similar stones which mark the route of the ancient road through Cornwall. 18P/28L is at East End, Redruth and 14P/24L is at Camborne in the grounds of Gladys Holman House. There is also 11P/21L, 10P/20L, 9P/19L, 8P/18L at Angarrack and Hayle. The terminal stone at Chyandour Cliff, Penzance is marked on one face just P and on the others 1687.

The stones continue to Lands End but are only marked with numerals.

Further up the A30 are more stones in the series such as 34L, 36L and 5R.

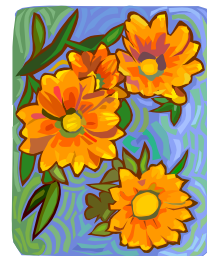
