A place for... Outreach Services

Every week we will be taking the therapy department into the community to provide therapy and exercise for those living with long-term neurological conditions.

Exercise provides many physical and mental benefits for individuals with Multiple Sclerosis and other neurological conditions. It has been shown to improve strength; bladder and bowel function; reduce fatigue; improved balance and posture; reduce falls and promote well-being, motivation and self esteem.

Two group exercise sessions will be held weekly at Aspire South West, Unit 15, Marsh Lane Industrial Estate, Hayle, TR27 5JR every Wednesday from 10.30am. Classes will be adapted to fit the needs of the clients. Once a month, at the same venue, there will be one to one sessions with our specialist neuro physiotherapist.

The service is for both registered and new clients of the Merlin MS Centre. Refreshments will be available after the exercise groups for clients and carers; and provide the opportunity to meet others in the community whose lives are affected by long-term conditions.

The cost of the classes and the one to one sessions, which are subsidised by the charity, will be the same as the Merlin MS Centre. Group sessions are £3 MS or £4 non-MS. Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy £17 a session MS Clients / £40 non-MS.

SCAMS

County Trading Standards is warning that a man is making calls purporting to be from Cornwall County Council Investigations Department. He says he is investigating accidents that the householder has been involved in. These calls are bogus.

Any caller who asks you to pay money with the promise of a larger refund, prize or compensation is clearly not to be trusted. Never pay money or provide your bank or credit card details to someone over the phone who has cold called you.

Another version is when the caller claims to be a Metropolitan police detective. They tell you that your bank card details have been used fraudulently.

They suggest you hang up and ring the bank or police to check the call is genuine but they stay on the line. They then tell you to give the card details and PIN or instruct you to withdraw cash from your account.

They send a courier (taxi) to collect your bank card. With this and your PIN they can withdraw your money.
