# heartlands

Heartlands in Pool is planned to transform Cornwall's most derelict urban area into a truly inspirational cultural landscape. Essential clearance work is now well underway to prepare the site for the major works which will be on going throughout 2010. Cornwall Council is delivering the £29.5million project with £22.3m funding from the Big Lottery Fund's Living Landmarks programme and additional funding from Cornwall Council and The Homes and Communities Agency, the National Housing and Regeneration Agency for England.

Heartlands will create a unique setting for a range of activities. Specific elements of the project include a new park and gardens area, one of the largest adventure playgrounds in Cornwall, exhibition and event areas, artist studios, a restaurant and community building.



## Heartlands team up with local artist to create eco friendly belly boards

After months of preparation, students from Pool Business and Enterprise College took to the waves at Gwithian Beach on individually created belly boards inspired by life in Cornwall, and made out of recycled wood.

Panels of un-used wood, which were collected from Heartlands at Robinson's Shaft in Pool by the year nine students, and were transformed into eco-friendly belly boards. The boards were illustrated with images chosen by the pupils, which depict stories gathered from their family members and local residents about life in Pool.

The project, named 'Lost Words, Found Objects', involves working with the local community to help develop the project and inspire the artists and designers working at Heartlands. The project was led by local artist Ben Cook. The event at Gwithian Beach named 'Exhibition in the Sea' gave pupils the opportunity to showcase their boards both in and out of the water.

The Lost Words, Found Objects project was an exciting opportunity for pupils of Pool Business and Enterprise College to get involved with Heartlands and have learnt that sustainable living can be fun. Raw materials, which were no longer of use on the Heartlands site have now been transformed into fantastic original belly boards for the pupils to surf on and will later be exhibited at Heartlands for all to see.

## MALCOLM'S MUNCHIES

### CORNISH HEAVY CAKE

6oz Plain Flour  
1½oz Lard  
1½oz Margarine  
1½oz Sugar  
3oz Mixed Fruit  
½tsp Salt

Mix flour, salt and fat roughly together. Add other ingredients and mix well. Mix with water to stiff dough. Roll out to approximately half inch thick into an oval shape. Criss cross with knife.

Bake at 350°F, Gas mark 4 for 25-30 minutes.
