The National Planning Policy Framework says that the purpose of the planning system is to contribute towards the achievement of sustainable development.

But what is sustainable development?

It is defined by the UN General Assembly as:

'meeting the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs'

(Resolution 42/187 of the United Nations General Assembly).

As members of the UN, the UK has agreed to pursue the 17 Global Goals for Sustainable Development' in the period to 2030.

These goals address environmental, social progress and economic objectives, which are carried forward in the National Planning Policy Framework and the Cornwall Local Plan.

The Carn Brea NDP thus links in to the UN's Sustainable Development Goals.

In doing so, we can contribute towards delivering and translating the high level goals of sustainable development into real local level action in our Parish.






