CV writing and job searches:

Work with your mentor to focus on your existing skills, and look for jobs that interest you.

Training:

Face-to-face or online training is available in a wide range of subjects, such as:

- · CSCS card (Construction Skills Certification Scheme)

Work placements:

Join one of Coastline's teams for a 2 - 8 week placement. Gain on the job experience, new skills, and increased confidence. Finish with a reference, onward support into work, and great memories!

We have placements in:

• The Homeless Service, housing services and other teams based at Coastline House, various trades, including repairs and maintenance, painting and decorating, and cleaning.

Coastline Construct:

Would you like to work in construction? If so, we can support you to gain your CSCS card and have a 2 week work experience placement on a live Coastline building site, in partnership with Mispace. You can learn the basics of labouring, to joining specific trade teams. Whether it's a new path for you or a return to the work place, we can support you with your next step.

Volunteering:

This is a great way to gain new skills, meet new people, and feel connected in your community. Volunteering gives people the chance to see what areas interest them most, and can lead to work opportunities. Volunteers tell us that they feel a real sense of reward for the time that they donate.
