



### **Forthcoming Events**

The **Tour of Britain** is scheduled to whiz through the parish for the first time ever on Sunday 5th September 2021, following the postponement of the 2020 race. The Grand Depart will see riders travel 180 kilometres through the Cornish countryside. The current route starts at Penzance Promenade then riders will head across the



Penwith Peninsula to St Just, hugging the coast to St Ives, Hayle and Gwithian before turning inland to Camborne, Pool and Redruth.

**Pool Vision** is a 6-week public consultation from Monday 23 August to Monday 4 October 2021. Carn Brea Parish Council and Cornwall Council are publishing a document called the 'Pool Vision' which sets out exciting ideas and proposals for the ongoing and future regeneration of the Pool area, covering issues such as how we improve the area's streets for pedestrians, cyclists, and residents, and how we can raise the quality of new development and public spaces. You will receive leaflets in the Pool area later in August with more details about the consultation: including how to view documents online and how to make comments. Online information will be on Cornwall Council's **Let's Talk Cornwall** website from 23 August 2021.



Our **Remembrance Day** commemorations will take place at the Carn Brea War Memorial, Treloweth Community Hall at 11am on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> November 2021. We are hoping to be back to our usual traditions for the service if Government guidance on Covid precautions allows: Flag Bearer representatives of the Armed Forces and wreath laying followed by a minute's silence whilst we remember those lost in service of our country and concluded with the Last Post. We also hope to be able to offer light refreshments to attendees.
