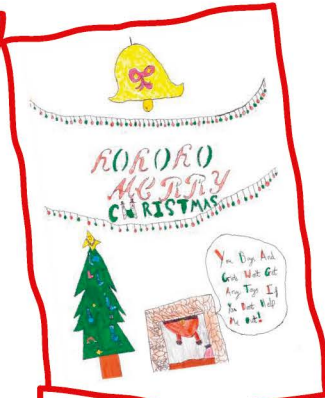

Annual Parish Awards:-

Clarence Coombe Memorial Award

The Council wishes to recognise outstanding achievements, by person or persons who have served Carn Brea Parish.

The Clarence Coombe Memorial Award is in memory of the late Clarence Coombe, a well-respected Councillor who served Carn Brea Parish for many years.

The award will be presented to a nominee, who has served in Carn Brea Parish and who has given lifelong service, performed a heroic deed, or attained individual achievement through work, study, conquest of illness or disability etc.

Marise Levenson Award

The Marise Levenson Memorial Award is in memory of the late Marise Levenson. The award recognises the contribution of young people in the community, and will be presented to a young person under the age of 18 who has served in Carn Brea Parish and who has contributed to the local community through charitable acts, altruistic caring acts, or unrecognised achievements etc.

The South Crofty Project Update: Feasibility Study and Dewatering

Currently progressing our upcoming Feasibility Study report, as part of our aim of ultimately bringing South Crofty into full production. We have completed the metallurgical test work drilling generating a bulk sample of core, as part of the Feasibility Study. This bulk sample will provide data on mineralisation, not only helping our geologists to model the mineral resource, but also giving us the raw material needed for testing the operational processes during the mine life. These processes include Ore Sorting, Mineral Processing, Paste Backfill parameters and Mine Design.

The construction of the Dewatering Plant is now complete, the process has been commissioned, permitted, and is ready for switch on, in late October 2023. This is a huge milestone for the project and will be a significant step closer to reopening the mine.

The South Crofty Project Update: 2023 Exploration Drilling – Carn Brea

The Exploration Drilling, which is currently underway on the South Flank of Carn Brea, is progressing well. The next phase of upcoming drillholes are aimed at defining the geological model further and begin to infill on the newly identified Wide Formation structure. The planned drilling program will continue on through and into 2024.

We are very thankful for all the Community Support received during our ongoing works.
