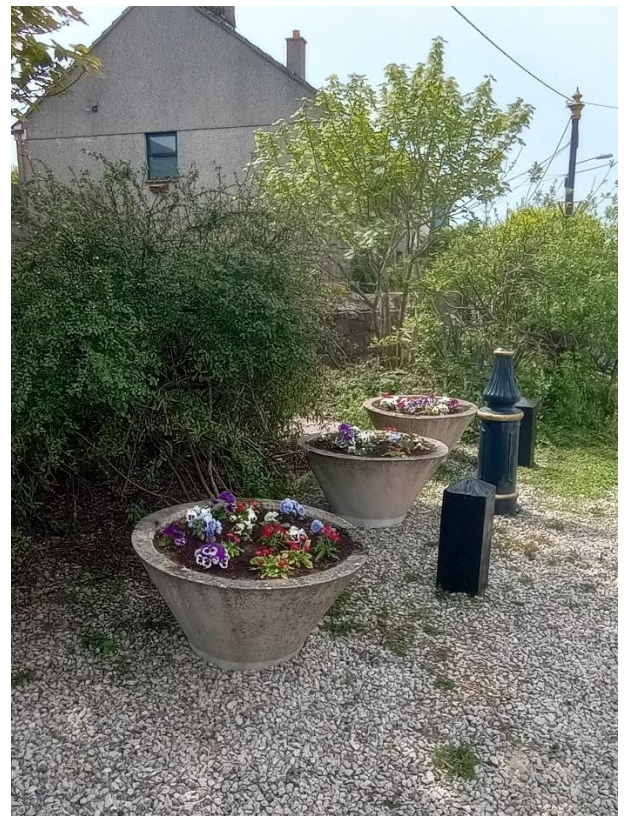
We will be providing food options, including hog roast/veggie option, ice cream/lollies and children's goodie bag all of which will be available on a ticket only basis.
