Supporting our Community: Grant Awards from Carn Brea Parish Council

We remain committed to enhancing the quality of life for residents by supporting local community groups through our grant programme. Grants are financial contributions awarded to voluntary, charitable and community organisations to help fund specific projects or activities that benefit the parish.

At our October Full Council meeting we were pleased to award:

- £2,000 to Four Lanes Snooker Club.
 This grant will support essential repairs and upgrades at the Four Lanes and Pencoys Snooker Club. The improvements aim to bring the facilities up to the high standard achieved during their previous renovation.
- £2,000 to YMCA Cornwall
 This funding contributes to their project to build four new flats, providing safe and stable housing for disadvantaged young people, many of whom have experienced repeated setbacks from both family and institutional systems.

We're proud to support initiatives that make a meaningful difference in our community.
