Your Parish Council have decided to create a **Neighbourhood Development Plan** to cover the whole parish and we want to hear your thoughts and ideas about what should be in it.

But what is a Neighbourhood Plan?

A Neighbourhood Plan MUST by law reflect local people's views of how they wish their area to develop. You have an opportunity to say where homes might be built and to draw up policies on how to protect the local environment and heritage. Also to try and ensure there are the school places, transport infrastructure and community services needed for the area. The plan links up to the Cornwall Local Plan which sets out planning and growth policies for the whole county until 2030. When completed our Plan will become important in future planning decisions.

Our Plan is specifically for Carn Brea Parish Council – so what can you do?

In this Newsletter is a **QUESTIONNAIRE** from us, looking for your views. The answers we get from you will help us give structure to the Plan. The Questionnaire is simple and quite basic. A more detailed questionnaire will be sent out in the future, to get more information. REPORT FROM CIIr Robert Hendry



Robert Hendry – Cornwall Councillor Four Lanes Division

Firstly, I would like to thank all of you, living in the Four Lanes Division, for your fantastic support to elect me as your new councillor in May. As your Independent councillor I aim to represent all of our community; to keep in regular contact and be easily accessible throughout the year. Already I am holding informal surgeries around the Division; to give local residents a chance to highlight their concerns and issues.

As a member of the Planning Panel (west) we are having training sessions every month to cover various issues surrounding planning, which I have quickly discovered is a minefield! I am also the Vice-Chair of the Audit Committee. As a committee we are also having training sessions to understand the complexities of the Cornwall Council accounts, which included being presented with the accounts of 2016/17, running into over 170 pages.

I work very closely with the Parish Council, especially with planning applications, and the ongoing Neighbourhood Plan. I am kept busy with individual residents concerns on a daily basis, and formulating action plans for the problems of speeding traffic in Carnkie, Piece and Four Lanes.

As a "newbie" I am finding it all very interesting, learning a lot, and at times very challenging. I hope to serve you all with the best of my ability.

RECYCLING

A recent Cornwall Council survey shows that Camborne Pool and Redruth are only recycling 18% of our recyclable waste.

Cornwall Cllr Sue James portfolio holder for environment and public protection says a social media campaign is beginning in order to raise awareness of what happens to our waste and the impact it has on the environment and of the cost to Cornwall Council.

It costs £185 a tonne to collect rubbish but only £110 to collect recycling. If everyone recycled Cornwall Council would save £2,706,000 a year!
