## Chairman's Update



### Parish Precept

Let's start the Updates with some good news! You will all have received your Council Tax Notices recently and you may have spotted that the portion which is our Parish Precept, has actually gone down by 4%! The reason for this is because this Council has been able to exercise prudent control over its expenditure. There has also been an increase in new homes in the parish, which increases the tax base.

### Treloweth Open Space

A little while ago, we highlighted the unsatisfactory situation regarding some dog walkers in Treloweth Open Space who were not picking up after their dogs. Several local residents have worked with us to try and improve matters. We are immensely grateful for their endeavours. Things are getting better, and cleaner. The Council have now had 'dog poo bins' erected at each exit and soon we will install two machines providing 'poo bags'. Thank you to everyone who has worked hard to make the park cleaner and safer.

### Four Lanes Traffic

The Council is continuing to support Four Lanes Cllr Robert Hendry CC/Parish Councillor in his campaign to calm and moderate traffic as it passes through Four Lanes. Robert has a number of proposals to tackle this very real difficulty and we are working with him to persuade Cornwall Council Highways to take effective action.

### Highways success story

With the support and co-operation of Cllr Philip Desmonde CC (Pool/Tehidy), we have arranged for Highways to place yellow lines in Gas Lane, Tolvaddon. This is the access road into the new development on Tolvaddon Road which contains Costa Coffee, KFC, Travelodge and Marston's The Copper Coast. Severe traffic congestion in Gas Lane was occurring and Highways have agreed to create an emergency scheme to alleviate the problem. Grateful thanks to Highways and to Cllr Desmonde.

### **Your Neighbourhood Development Plan Update!**

After months of hard work and revision, the Carn Brea Parish Neighbourhood Development Plan Steering Group have produced a detailed questionnaire to get your opinions on a wide range of issues, and it will be arriving (or may have arrived!) on your doorstep. This is a significant milestone, as your responses will form the basis for the policies, which will form the Carn Brea Parish Neighbourhood Development Plan. Please take time to complete and return it, and also talk to your neighbours and family and make sure they have completed the questionnaire too – there is a prize draw!

The Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group have also been exploring creating development boundaries in certain parts of the Parish. Consultations have so far taken place with the residents and landowners of Tregajorran, Carn Brea Village, Carnkie, Piece and Bowling Green. In general, development inside the boundary will be seen as favourable, subject to the usual planning rules, regulations and permissions. Outside of the boundary, any development will not normally be permitted – it would have to adhere to exception site rules. There are pros and cons to having development boundaries so this has been an interesting time, consulting with residents and landowners.

Members of the Neighbourhood Development Plan Steering Group and additional volunteers have also now received training on Local Landscape Character Assessment. Those trained are now able to assess the unique characteristics of different parts of the Parish. This information can then be incorporated into the policies which make up the plan. We are hoping for some good weather to get assessing in!
