



## **CO-OPTION**

### **Four Lanes Ward**

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 89 (6) of the Local Government Act 1972 that a Casual Vacancies exist for the Four Lanes Ward of Carn Brea Parish Council.

The Parish Council must now co-opt suitably qualified person(s) to serve as Councillor for the aforementioned Ward.

Any person wishing to be considered for co-option should in the first instance, contact the Clerk & Proper Officer of Carn Brea Parish Council to obtain a Co-option Eligibility Form.

Persons eligible for consideration must:

- a. Be aged 18 years or over, and
- b. He/she is a British citizen, Commonwealth citizen, citizen of the Irish Republic or a citizen of another European Union State.
- c. He/she is and thereafter continues to be a local government elector for the Parish of Carn Brea; or
- d. He/she has during the whole of the twelve months preceding, occupied as owner or tenant, any land or other premises in the Parish of Carn Brea; or
- e. His/her principal or only place of work during the last twelve months has been in the Parish of Carn Brea; or
- f. He/she has during the last twelve months resided in the Parish of Carn Brea; or
- g. He/she has during the last twelve months resided within three miles (4.8 kilometres) of the Parish of Carn Brea.

The closing date for the receipt of applications is Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> October 2020.
