Chy Wetha, Blowinghouse, Redruth, Cornwall, TR15 3AS Change of use of former shop and conversion of cellar storage area below to single dwelling house.

that Carn Brea Parish Council object to PA23/04879 on the following grounds:-

- We are of the view that the works intended, and actually now being undertaken on site, go beyond the status of Permitted Development Rights and therefore the application should be for Full Planning Permission.
- 2. This is based on the terms of the Town & Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015. Part 7 alterations to shop premises allow permitted development only when alterations are on the ground floor level only. The application shows alterations to the ground floor, and the first floor. We are aware that work has been carried out to the roof. The degree and extent of the work therefore removes this application from being purely Permitted Development.
- If it is accepted that Full Planning Permission should be applied for then details of the exterior finishes should be provided, given that two exterior walls have been removed. Details of windows and doors, including proposed colours, should be provided.
- 4. We draw attention to the apparent absence of the required amenity space as set down in the Cornwall Design Guide, Section 9, at paras 9.5.6 and 9.5.7.
- 5. We draw attention to the lack of parking space at the property, see the Cornwall Design Guide, Section 5, sub sections 5.7 and 5.8.
- 6. We draw attention to the fact this property is immediately adjacent to a Grade II Listed Building, the Barncoose Tollhouse. At present it is not possible to understand from the Application what exterior finishes will be used, or the impact of the appearance of the shop conversion and upstairs level on the Grade II Listed property.
- 7. Our view is that the current application for Change of Use is not appropriate, it should be refused and the applicant should submit an Application for Full Planning Permission.
