Erection of two new semi-detached dwellings.

The applicant for 24/028 arrived during discussions.

Cllr Drew advised the applicant that item 7, to allow registered elector members of the Parish to speak of planning applications on the agenda had been dealt with, and as he had arrived late, that he had missed his opportunity to speak regarding the application.

The meeting reviewed the plans and discussed the history of this application including height, scale, overlooking, overall appearance, surrounding environment and loss of Cornish hedging/trees.

Resolved: that Carn Brea Parish Council object to the application PA24/02437 on the following grounds:

- Cornwall Local Plan Policy 2 Respecting and enhancing quality of place. The contemporary design of the proposed development fails to demonstrate a physical and aesthetic understanding of its location i.e. the site sits between two single storey bungalows, of similar appearance, neither of which are of such a contemporary design.
- Cornwall Local Plan Policy 12 Design.
 - (a) The contemporary design of the proposed development fails to be of an appropriate scale, density, height and mass, and fails to show a clear understanding and response to its landscape setting.
 - (b) Also the proposal creates the potential for overlooking, overshadowing and overbearing impacts.
- Cornwall Design Guide External Amenity.
 - (a) The current layout of the proposal fails to meet the standard set out in para. 9.5. 7 in respect of adequate amenity space
 - (b) The application fails to comply with para. 9.5.12 and 9.5.13 and Appendix 2 in respect of the storage requirements for recycling and refuse. There is no space identified within the dwellings and importantly there is no garage provision for either dwelling.
- Carn Brea Neighbourhood Development Plan Policy NE3.
 The proposed development does not comply with Policy NE3 in that it does not maintain the visual separation of established development, openness and landscape value, and in particular fails to retain the proportion and scale of existing built structures, and also fails to reference the built vernacular of the neighbourhood area.
- Cornwall Local Plan Policy 23.2 the development fails to comply with this standard
- CBPC wish to draw attention to the discrepancies between the application form and the design and access statement with reference to vehicle parking, front Cornish hedge and trees on the site.


