**24/08/P/01 Welcome and Fire Procedures.**

The Chairman welcomed the meeting and explained the fire procedures.

**24/08/P/04 To consider written request(s) for dispensations.**

There were no written requests for dispensations.

**24/08/P/05 To allow registered elector members of the Parish to speak in respect of Planning Applications on the agenda. (Maximum of 20 minutes – every speaker has a limit of 3 minutes under Council Standing Orders).**

There was one member of the public present who was the applicant for PA24/04420. They did not wish to speak on their application, but agreed to answer any questions that councillors might have.



**24/047** Land Adjacent to Kevill Road, Pool, Redruth, Cornwall  
**PA24/05568** Erection of 8 dwellings

**Resolved:** that Carn Brea Parish Council support the application PA24/05568 subject to the following:

- Request that the file is noted for Section 106 contributions if further properties in excess of 10 are developed.
- We require clarification regarding foul sewage as the application says the properties will not be connected to the existing foul sewage system.
- We note there is no provision for the storage of waste or recycled waste as per the Cornwall Design Guide.
- Further we note there are no facilities for EV charging or no secure cycle parking and storage as per CLP Policy 16 and Climate Emergency DPD Policy.

**24/048** The Railway Inn, 79 Agar Road, Illogan Highway, Redruth, TR15 3EF  
**PA24/05481** Expansion of the use of the existing use of public house drinking establishment with expanded food provision to add hot food takeaway.

**Resolved:** that Carn Brea Parish Council support PA24/05481, but draw the attention of the Case Officer to the application form saying there is no provision for waste, recycling waste or trade waste.

**24/049** Western United Mines Ltd, South Crofty Mine, Dudnace Lane, Pool, TR15 3QT  
**PA24/05628** Prior approval under Part 17 Class B of the Town and Country Planning (GPDO) 2015 for Existing North Winder Building to be replaced with a new building replicating the dimensions of the winder house that was previously in place (from 1986 - 2005). The current building was constructed to weatherproof the winder. The building will contain, existing winder (refurbished in situ), control kiosk, and various control systems (electrical drives, hydraulics, motors and gearboxes). Winder enclosure will be constructed of steel frame (columns fixed to existing concrete foundations), metal cladded (twin skin insulated) and a large roller door to ensure future proof maintenance. 25t Gantry crane will be enclosed within the building to enable construction and refurbishment of the existing winder.

**Resolved:** that Carn Brea Parish Council does not support this application but does support the principle of the redevelopment of the site, we would ask that the consideration be given to the management of waste and recycling as per Cornwall Design Guide Appendix 2. Also the Council have a concern about vehicle access and egress to and from the site.
