



Illogan Highway

Highway improvement works are scheduled to begin on Monday 23 February. We plan to complete the project by Friday 24 April.

To facilitate the improvements, three-way traffic lights will be installed along Agar Road and Barncoose Terrace. As the scheme progresses, traffic management will switch to two-way traffic lights. To minimise disruption and help maintain traffic flow, the lights will be manually controlled during peak times.

For everyone's safety and to reduce waiting times, a short section of Chariot Road will be closed from 23 February to 2 April.

Work will take place from 7.30 am and 4.30pm, Monday to Friday. However, weekend work may be necessary when traffic movements are lower to ensure the project stays on schedule.



What work is taking place?

Our work will involve installing new cycle lanes, improved pedestrian crossings, enhanced bus shelters, and protected parking bays along Barncoose Avenue.

The project forms part of a wider 'aspiration/vision' for Pool, to improve walking, cycling and public transport access. As well as encouraging the use of the A3047 through Barncoose Industrial Estate instead.

Additional 'gateway' landscaping will also be incorporated and will follow later in the year.

Access arrangements

Access will be maintained for residents and businesses within the works areas. However, due to the nature of the work, there may be short delays. We will do our best to minimise disruption as much as possible.


Suitable barrier systems will be in place to safely separate and guide pedestrians around our works.

Please be aware of the following hazards while the footway work is taking place.

- Uneven road surface where the old surface has been removed
- Raised manhole, gullies, and other service boxes
- Temporary storage of machinery and vehicles

Diversion

Signs will be placed at major junctions prior to the road closure on the key routes.
