



Illogan Highway

As part of the next phase of the project on Illogan Highway, improvement works will continue until completion on Friday 15 May.

To facilitate the work, two-way traffic lights will remain in place along Barncoose Terrace. However, please note that traffic management will change from the week commencing 4 May, when four-way traffic lights will be introduced. This change is necessary to manage the scope of work. To minimise disruption and maintain traffic flow, the lights will be manually controlled during peak times and throughout the day as needed.

Work will take place from 7.30 am to 4.30pm, Monday to Friday. However, weekend work may be necessary when traffic movements are lower to ensure the project stays on schedule.

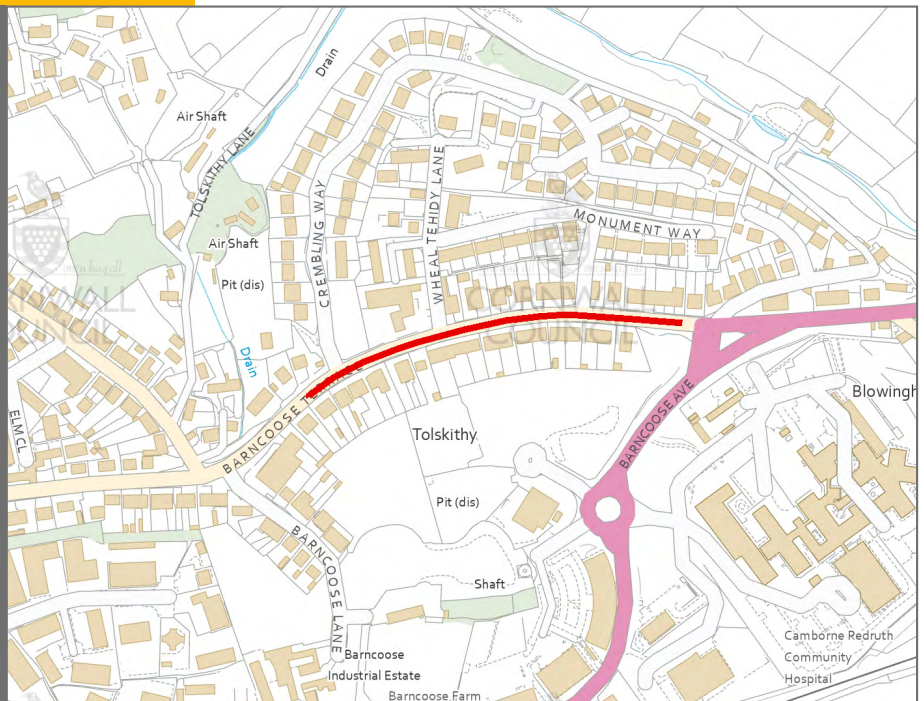

What work is taking place?

This phase of the project will involve repairs to the footways and the installation of signs and road markings.

After this work is complete, overnight resurfacing will begin and is expected to take two weeks. Further information regarding dates and scheduling will be shared.

Additional 'gateway' landscaping will follow later in the year.

The project forms part of a wider 'aspiration/vision' for Pool, to improve walking, cycling and public transport access. As well as encouraging the use of the A3047 through Barncoose Industrial Estate instead.

Access arrangements

Access will be maintained for residents and businesses within the works areas. However, due to the nature of the work, there may be short delays. We will do our best to minimise disruption as much as possible.

A temporary pedestrian crossing will be available while the four-way temporary traffic lights are in operation.

Suitable barrier systems will be in place to safely separate and guide pedestrians around our works.

Please be aware of the following hazards while the footway work is taking place.

- Uneven road surface where the old surface has been removed
- Raised manhole, gullies, and other service boxes
- Temporary storage of machinery and vehicles
