# Looking Back & Looking Ahead

## 2026-2027

The Precept Carn Brea Parish Council has set for 2026/2027 is £279,000 which represents an 0.2% increase (£0.17p for the year) on a Band D Property at £103.88 per annum.

In 2025, after a significant review and planning, the Council submitted a planning application to Cornwall Council for improvement and extension works to Treloweth Community Hall. The works are necessary to future proof the facilities for the Parish Team and Grounds Person. The works will be largely funded by existing reserves that have been set aside for this project, however due to a significant increase in building materials and labour, the Council will be looking to apply for a loan to ensure that the project can be delivered which is included in the budget calculations.

A big focus for Carn Brea Parish Council in 2025 was continuing its work to make improvements to the Council's Open Spaces and more on the exciting project at Moorfield Road later in the Newsletter!

In 2025, in the 3rd year of the Council's project to provide 24hr a day accessible Defibrillator Units, the Council, working with Duchy Defibrillators and Bleed Control Cornwall, upgraded the cabinet at the Co-Op on Higher Broad Lane and following the donation of 3 kits from Bleed Control Cornwall, have invested in providing Bleed Kits for all 7 of the existing cabinets within the Parish. The Council are continuing to review suitable locations for future Defibrillator installations and hope to install further cabinets in 2026/2027.

# Budget 2026-2027

Due to rising costs, in 2026 the Council will be reviewing how they disseminate information to everyone in the Parish which may mean a change to the quarterly newsletters, however day to day information regarding Parish news, events and activities as well as useful community and County based information is provided for everyone to access on the Council's Facebook page.

# Moorfield Road Improvement Project Update 2026



## Background - What's happened so far....

In 2025 the Carn Brea Parish Council embarked on a project with the aim of making improvements to the Open Space it owns at Moorfield Road, Pool following the successful installment of a play park at Wheal Fortune Park.

In June 2025 the Council were successful in obtaining a grant from Cornwall Council's Community Capacity Fund to work with consultants to create a concept design and conduct public consultations.

The Council partnered with a local company, Mei Loci, who held consultation events with the local Schools in Pool and 1<sup>st</sup> Pool Brownies and collated responses from the online survey that was available from 1<sup>st</sup> August - 30<sup>th</sup> September 2025.

In addition to the valuable contributions and ideas from the School groups and the Brownies, the Council received 77 responses to the survey, and after pulling all that data together, a draft design was created and signed off by the Council in November 2025.

In January this year, the Final Public Consultation took place and the proposed improvement designs were shared on the Council's Website & Facebook Page and were displayed at Treloweth Community Hall where everyone was invited to comment on the proposed improvements.

# Moorfield Road Improvement Project Update 2026

## Going Forward - So where are we now....

Following the positive feedback received from the Public Consultation, the Council are continuing to work with the consultants Mei Loci on the exciting next stage of the project which is to look at the technical drawings and estimates of how much the project will cost.

The Council has some existing funds available that have been earmarked for the improvements and the Council have not increased the precept to pay for the project. Unfortunately there's not enough in the pot to pay for the whole project, so the Council will be working with the consultants to research grants that may be available in order to complete the improvements!
