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Meeting Minutes of the Extraordinary Full Council

Minutes:

1. Chairman's welcome and safety procedures.

The Chairman welcomed the meeting and explained the safety procedures

2. To receive apologies for non-attendance.

3. Members to declare disclosable pecuniary interests and non-registerable interests (including the details thereof) in respect of any items on this agenda.

6. To receive an update on the Pool Corridor project including the proposed Balmaiden sculpture design and consider the requests for support and agree next steps making appropriate resolutions.

Presentation slides were provided to Councillors ahead of the meeting and the Clerk took the meeting through the update on the project and outlined the request for support regarding the history of the Balmaidens and their descendants.

The update provided was well received with positive feedback on the scheme and the recently completed road layout works along Barncoose Terrace.

The meeting discussed potential sources and actions to gather information to support the project, including:

- Kresen Kernow records office
- South Crofty Mines historical records

- Develop a Facebook post asking for any descendants of a Balmaiden
- Potential to utilise Radio Cornwall

The meeting agreed that the Clerk would create a post for Facebook encouraging any descendants of a Balmaiden to contact the office to share any stories or information.

The meeting raised concerns about missing highway signage, road markings and the lack of a marked area for vehicles turning right into Chariot Road and also discussed the proposed landscape scheme regarding tree species and their height and the potential for these once grown to obscure the view of oncoming traffic at the junction and the omission in the landscape scheme design of the proposed Highways Maintenance Vehicle Bay that the Council had recently been consulted on. It was agreed that the Clerk feedback these comments.
